

## **New Engineering Management Manual for TIDC projects**

TIDC's engineering practices and processes have been streamlined and a new Engineering Management Manual has been developed, following a six-month review of its engineering standards.

This review took into account a range of factors including the Rail Safety Act 2008 (which came into effect on 1 January 2009), the requirements of the TIDC Safety Plan and key learning outcomes from TIDC projects.

The Engineering Management Manual was introduced in July 2009 and is now in use on all TIDC projects.

The Manual brings together and expands on TIDC'S engineering systems and processes in one central document and covers both design and construction.

By clearly articulating the roles and responsibilities of TIDC's Engineering Group and its contractors, the Manual serves to ensure consistency across and within TIDC projects and will assist in the continued delivery of high quality infrastructure for the people of NSW.
