TIDC engaged the services of an experienced consultant to fill a vacant Portfolio Scheduler position.

This critical position seeks to ensure TIDC maintains a consistent approach to programming across each project and portfolio, and involves schedule maintenance, implementing the planning objectives of the PMO, understanding the multiple and complex interfaces involved in the projects, overseeing and coordinating the portfolio programs and developing standard policy and procedures for time management and improvement of the master schedule across all TIDC projects.

Due to a market scarcity of quality planners with adequate relevant experience in construction and rail projects, and the necessity to fill the role as quickly as possible, a proposal was sought from an experienced planner with the essential skills and specific experience to successfully fulfil this role.
